In continuation to this office letter No.MCI-34(41)(E-17)/2019-Med./116805, dated 23/05/2019 and your letter No. GMC/Ang/Estt./2019/893 dated 24.05.2019 furnishing required undertaking, I am directed to convey the formal permission of the Board of Governors for establishment of a new medical college at Anantnag, Jammu & Kashmir in the name and style of "Govt. Medical College, Anantnag, Jammu & Kashmir" with annual intake of 100 MBBS students for the academic year 2019-2020 under Section 10A of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956.

2. This permission of the Board of Governors in supersession of the MCI accorded initially for a period of one year and will be renewed on yearly basis subject to verification of achievement of annual targets as indicated in your scheme. This process of renewal of permission will continue till such time the infrastructure and expansion of hospital facilities are completed as per norms of Medical Council of India and the college is recognized. The next batch of students shall be admitted only after obtaining permission of the Board of Governors in supersession of the MCI.

3. Admissions made in violation of the above condition will be treated as irregular and action will be initiated under IMC Act & Regulations made there under.

4. The Government Medical Colleges (except those located in J & K States) shall contribute 15% of MBBS seats for which the renewal permission is granted for all India quota.

5. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of the Board of Governors in supersession of the MCI and the State Govt.

With reference to your application for renewal of permission for admission of 2nd batch of 100 MBBS students at Government Medical College, Anantnag, J&K submitted u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 to now dissolved Board of Governors in Supersession of the Medical Council of India. It is brought to your notice that the Central Government has on 24th September 2020 notified fully the NMC Act, 2019. Section 61(2) of the NMC Act, 2019 provides as under:

"Notwithstanding the repeal of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956, the educational standards, requirements and other provisions of the Indian Medical Council Act, 1956 and the rules and regulations made there under shall continue to be in force and operate till new standards or requirements are specified under this Act or the rules and regulations made there under."


2. Accordingly your application was processed u/s 10A of the IMC Act, 1956 and Establishment of New Medical Colleges Regulations, 1999. I am directed to convey the permission of the Medical Assessment and Rating Board of the National Medical Commission for renewal of permission for admission of 2nd batch of 100 (one hundred) MBBS students at Government Medical College, Anantnag, J&K u/s 28 read with section 61(2) of NMC Act, 2019 for the academic year 2020-21.
